## **DND** indication on **DSS** Console.

This is a common request when a user upgrades (or downgrades as some would say) to an IVS/IVS2/IPS from a Key System. By default the NEC key system displays the DND status of a station on a DSS console. With the IVS/IVS2/IPS this is obtainable with the following programming.

- 1. First you must assign the Console to the system using CM's 10, 96, and 97.
- 2. Using CM 97 assign a DND Set-Reset key to key 57 E.g. 97>00,57>F1053.
- 3. Now when a station is placed in DND the LED to the top right of the DSS key will light green.
- 4. If key 57 is depressed (LED top left of key red) any station selected on the DSS will be placed into DND or removed depending on the status.
- 5. To stop this from being pressed (Fat finger dialing) you can remove the 2 screws from the back of the unit after confirming the key is in the off position and unit unplugged. Inside another 6 screws removed enables you to pull out the PC board. On the key side you will see a rubber mat covering the buttons and LED's. Lift the rubber mat and place a small piece of cellophane tape over the white lines under the button marked L58. Note 1.
- Carefully re-assemble the DSS unit.
  Now pressing this DND key will have no effect and the DSS feature will stay in place.

Note 1: Performing step 5 and 6 will void NEC warranty on the DSS console device. Perform this step at your own discretion as it is NOT necessary.
